Our client, a large detoxification and residential treatment center, received a letter from a major health insurer notifying the center that they would be suspending authorization for treatment services due to various purported member safety and quality of care concerns. Our attorney, [Aviva Morady](#), drafted a rebuttal letter, addressing each of the purported concerns. She then led a team that prepared a “performance improvement plan” for the client to follow. The insurer approved of the plan and agreed to lift the suspension of authorization allowing for the continued treatment of their members.
